### **Ft surcharge during January – April 2023**

The Electricity Regulatory Commission (ERC) passed a resolution concurring the Automatic Adjustment Mechanism (Ft) is going to be collected from the customers in electrical invoice during January to April 2023 as following;

- 1) Ft surcharge for residential customers is 0.9343 baht/kWh
- 2) Ft surcharge for other customers (non-residential) is 1.5492 baht/kWh

## Ft surcharge during January - April 2023

The Electricity Regulatory Commission (ERC), on the meeting on December 26th and 28th, 2022, passed a resolution concurring that the Automatic Tariff Adjustment Mechanism (Ft) is going to be collected from the customers in the electrical invoice during January to April 2023, which is equal to 0.9343 baht/kWh (excluding VAT) for residential customers and 1.5492 baht/kWh (excluding VAT) for other customers (non-residential). The details of the ERC's consideration are as follows:

1. The calculation's result of the Ft surcharge for retail electrical price during January to April 2023 is 1.4574 baht/kWh, for the reason that the Ft increased due to higher fuel prices in line with energy prices in the world market, particularly liquefied natural gas (LNG), which has a high price and the proportion of imports has increased, including the situation of depreciating exchange rates. As a result, the Ft is much higher.

2. The ERC considers the Ft's calculation according to the National Energy Policy Council (NEPC) on December 25th, 2022, set a policy to mitigate impact of Ft surcharge charge for residential customers by allocating natural gas from the Gulf of Thailand behind Gas Separation Plant to be generated electricity for residential customers as the first priority in the amount that does not increase the electricity price from the current rate. Accordingly, the retail Ft surcharge during January to April 2023 are as follows:

1) Ft surcharge for residential customers is 0.9343 baht/kWh (excluding VAT) by allocating natural gas from the Gulf of Thailand behind Gas Separation Plant to be generated electricity for residential customers as the first priority in the amount that does not increase the electricity price from the current.

2) Ft surcharge for other customers (non-residential) is 1.5492 baht/kWh (excluding VAT).
